SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Eligibility

Scholarships are open to any member of the EAHS senior class who is presently participating in the high school instrumental program and who will be attending a certified educational institution upon graduation from high school. The candidate must be actively involved in the EAHS instrumental music program for three (3) consecutive years, with the full senior year being spent in a program at Easton Area High School. The instrumental program shall consist of, but not be limited to, Band, Band Front, Orchestra, and Jazz Band and Chamber Strings.

Standards

Selection will be based on instrumental achievement, academic achievement, extracurricular activities, community activities, class rank, and participation in instrumental ensembles, both co-curricular and extra-curricular.

Amount

The IMA will award a minimum of three (3) scholarships. Two will be based on the above-mentioned standards and the **third will be based on musical accomplishments, with less emphasis on academics.**

Application Procedure

Applications can be obtained from the Guidance Office. All applications and related materials must be returned to the Guidance Office by **April 23, 2010**. Any applications sent elsewhere or submitted after that date will not be eligible for consideration.

After the identity of the applicant has been removed by the Guidance Office, the application(s) will be forwarded to the chairperson of the scholarship committee.

Announcement

The winners of the scholarships will be announced at the annual Instrumental Music Association Awards Banquet.

Give a **brief statement of goals and ambitions** upon graduation from high school and an institute of higher education.

Return completed application with letters of recommendation to the EAHS Guidance Office by **April 23, 2010**. Applications will be anonymous to the selection committee. The selection committee will disqualify any incomplete applications.
